

## **Job Description for Full-Time Science Teacher Temporary position until July 2025**

**Job Title:** Science Teacher (Full-time)  
**Main purpose:** Teaching of Science for Key Stages 3 and 4  
**Reporting Line:** Head of Science and Assistant Principal (Academic)

### **MAIN DUTIES**

- Ensuring the provision of an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for pupils studying Science, in accordance with the policies and aims of the school
- Maintain up-to-date records of attendance, assessment, planning, reports and communication with parents
- Monitoring differentiation strategies and their success
- Maintaining an up-to-date awareness of subject trends and pedagogy
- Regularly reviewing schemes of work
- Encouraging the use of a wide range of resources within the department
- Encouraging the exchanging of articles from newspapers, magazines and journals to develop enthusiasm for the subject area
- Maximising the potential of all pupils, through departmental activities, such as day trips and outside lectures
- Encouraging professional development through courses and INSET.
- Attend staff meetings where appropriate, teach at least one Easter revision session per year and supervise at least three after school clubs per week. All staff are expected to be on site until 5pm each working day.
